REGISTRATION

All teams participating in the tournament will be required to turn in signed waiver forms from each player, before they will be able to take the field for play.

REFEREES

A one-man system will be used for all age groups.

RULES

I. Field of Play

- Games will be played on half of a full sized soccer field.
- Goals will be the standard 8' x 24'

II. Number of Players

- The game will be played 6 v 6, five (5) field players and one (1) goalie
- Substitutions will be allowed on kick-ins by either team, after a goal, or a goal kick by either team.
- Minimum number of players to start or continue a game is four (4).

III. Equipment

- All players MUST wear shin guards
- Any shoe may be worn, as long as it is not dangerous to another player
- Players with casts and braces will be permitted to play, based on referees discretion
- Game balls will be provided for all games

IV. Duration of Games

- All games will be 25 minutes in length.

V. Rules

- USSF rules will be used at United Sports Training Center.
- NO OFF-SIDES, NO Slide Tackles
- NO Throw-ins, only KICK-INS, all kick-ins are INDIRECT.
- All Punts, Goal Kicks, and throws by the goalkeeper must touch a player or the ground before going over midfield.

VI. Misconduct

- Any player receiving a caution CAN stay on the field.
- Red carded players must leave the field of play, and the team with the red carded player must play shorthanded for the remainder of the game. Two yellow cards in a game equal a red card.
- Any player receiving a red card must sit out the next scheduled game (minimum)
- At the discretion of the referee, any unruly player may be sent away from the field.
- Coaches who are sent off must sit out the remainder of the current game and the next scheduled game (minimum)

VII. Performance Ranking Criteria

1. Ranking in each division is based on a point system
 - Win – 3 Points Tie – 1 Point Loss – 0 Points
2. A tie breaking system will be used as follows:
 - Head to head competition (Does not apply if two or more teams are tied)
 - Total goals against
 - Goal differential (Maximum 4 goals)
 - Head to head playoff (sudden death)

The decision of the Tournament Director is final THERE WILL BE NO PROTESTS!

HOTEL RESERVATION PROCESS

- Rooms will be reserved with more hotels
- The reservation process, especially if done online, will be quicker, more secure, and an electronic confirmation of your reservation will be sent
- Each team can choose what hotel they want to stay at and the length of their stay (based on availability)

Please be aware that all hotel rooms **MUST** be reserved through the CCCVB. Those teams that do not use the CCCVB will be subject to disciplinary actions, which may be exclusion from the tournaments. Teams are not permitted to use any other travel agent or reservation service. If you have already reserved rooms, the CCCVB will help you change those reservations to an approved hotel. Most likely, you will be able to stay at the hotel you already selected.
